



Appendix 1

PROTECTIVE ORDER

- For the purpose of this Protective Order, "Confidential Information" shall mean all documents
 constituting an unabridged listing of all encroachments and their related fee schedules (Exhibit J) as
 well as all documents constituting WCRS's proof of financial ability (Exhibit K).
- 2. Confidential Information constituting Exhibit J was previously provided to WCRS by Greenville County Economic Development Corporation upon request of WCRS, and shall not, therefore, be provided to any other parties, excepting the Board.
- 3. Confidential Information constituting Exhibit K shall be provided to any employee, agent, or counsel of WCRS only pursuant to this Protective Order and only upon execution and delivery of an Undertaking, provided as Appendix 2 of this document, to those parties providing those documents which make up Exhibit K in its entirety.
- 4. Confidential Information outlined in Item 2 and Item 3 of this Protective Order shall be used solely for the purpose of this and any related Board proceedings, or any judicial review proceeding arising therefrom, and not for any other business, commercial, or other competitive purpose.
- 5. Confidential Information shall not be disclosed in any way or to any person without the written consent of both WCRS and those parties providing those documents or an order by the Board, solely for use in connection with this and related Board proceedings, or any judicial review proceeding arising therefrom, and then only provided that such person has been given and has read a copy of this Protective Order and agrees to be bound by its terms by executing an Undertaking, provided as Appendix 2 of this document, prior to receiving access to this information.
- 6. Any documents containing Confidential Information must be either returned to WCRS or must be destroyed, and notice of such destruction must be served on WCRS at the completion of this and any related Board proceedings, or any judicial review proceeding arising therefrom, whichever comes first.
- 7. If the Board retains the Confidential Information, it shall, in order to keep it confidential, treat the information in accordance with the procedure set forth in 49 CFR 1104.14.

- 8. If any party intends to use the Confidential Information at hearings in this proceeding or in any related Board proceedings, or any judicial review proceeding arising therefrom, the party shall submit any documents setting forth or revealing such Confidential Information to the Board, or the reviewing court as appropriate, under seal, and shall accompany such submission with a written request to the Board or the court to 1) restrict attendance at the hearing during discussion of such Confidential Information, and 2) restrict access to the portion of the record or briefs reflecting discussion of such Confidential Information in accordance with this Protective Order.
- 9. All parties must comply with all of the provisions stated in this Protective Order unless good cause, as determined by the Board, is shown by any party to warrant suspension of any of the provisions herein.
